## Did you know that?

- The Cuyahoga County Board of Health requires that all dogs, cats and ferrets be vaccinated against the rabies virus.
- Vaccinating your pet helps create a buffer to protect you and your family from the deadly rabies virus.
- Wild mammals, including bats, raccoons, skunks, coyotes and foxes, can carry and transmit the rabies virus to humans or pets.
- You should avoid feeding wild animals, approaching wildlife or picking up an injured animal while at a park or in the woods.
