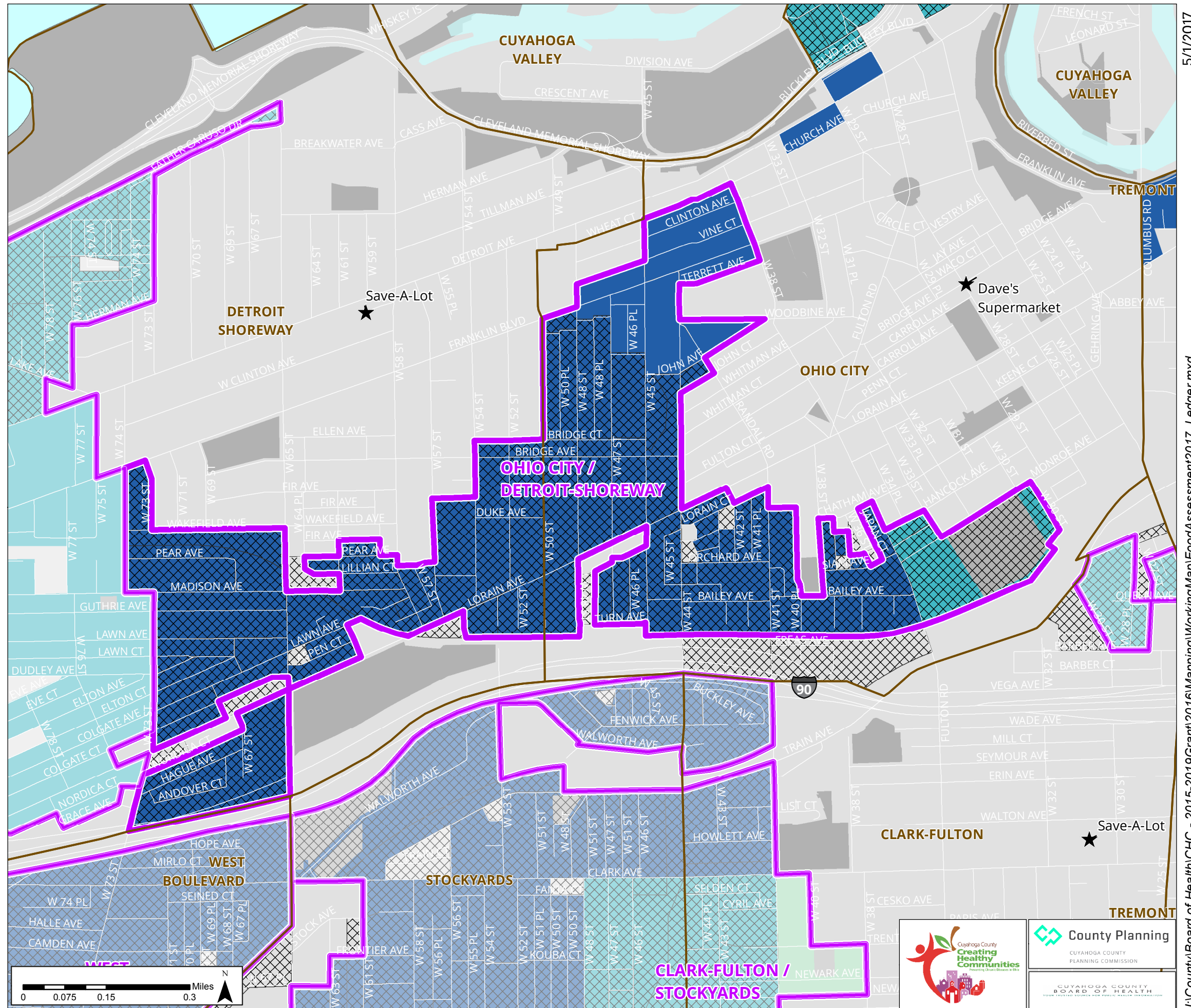

 Less than 1/2 mile to nearest grocery - OR  
**Income:**  
 Less than 30% of population below 200% of poverty level - OR  
**Population:**  
 Less than 10 persons per census block
