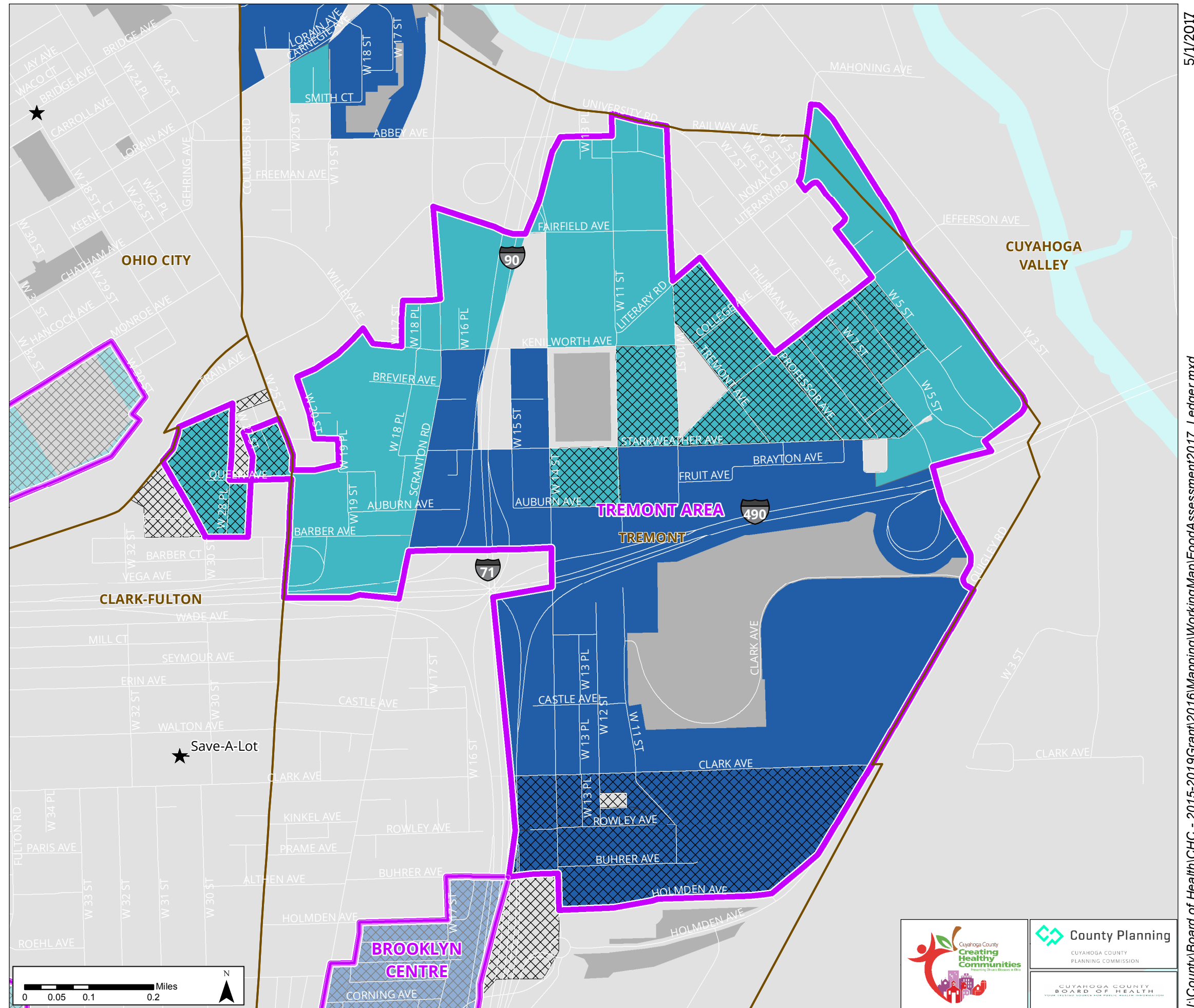

 Less than 30% of population below 200% of poverty level - OR
Population:
 Less than 10 persons per census block
