

## **Cleveland TGA Services**

### **Primary Medical Care**

Provides office visits with an HIV specialist and/or nurse as well as coverage for laboratory tests.

### **Drug Assistance**

Assistance with prescription medications for HIV/AIDS related health conditions.

### **Oral Health Care**

Preventative dental care as well as therapeutic dental treatment for existing problems.

### **Medical Transportation**

Assistance provided by bus, van or other means to help clients get to all medical appointment.

### **Health Insurance Assistance**

Assistance with private health insurance, paying co-pays, deductibles, and premiums.

### **Housing Services**

Assistance with gaining and maintaining safe and reliable housing.

### **Substance Abuse Treatment**

Professional counseling services to address alcohol or drug abuse and addiction programs.

### **Nutrition Services**

Services including nutritional counseling, food bank, and home delivered meals.

### **Mental Health Services**

Mental health treatment and counseling services offered to individuals or in a group setting.

### **Medical Case Management**

Helps individuals access Ryan White programs and navigate the system of care.

## What is the Ryan White Part A Program?

The Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program provides HIV-related services throughout the United States to those who do not have sufficient health care coverage or financial resources for coping with the disease.

## Who is Eligible for Ryan White Part A Services in the Cleveland TGA?

HIV Positive People Who:

- Live in the Cleveland TGA
- Meet the programs income guidelines
- Are uninsured or underinsured

## How Do I Know If I Qualify For Services?

To determine if you qualify for the program, contact the Ryan White Part A Office. They will put you in touch with a provider who can help determine your eligibility.

## What do I have to bring with me to apply for services?

- A photo ID
- Proof of Cleveland TGA Residency
- Proof of Income
- Proof of HIV Status
- Proof of Insurance including Medicaid and Medicare (if applicable)

- ➔ Were you recently diagnosed as HIV+ and don't know where to turn?
- ➔ Were you receiving treatment but dropped out of care and want to reconnect with a doctor?
- ➔ Were you receiving care but moved and need to find a new physician?
