  - Minimum of two years of experience as an SIT.
- For Sanitarian-in-Training (SIT)
  - Meets educational requirements necessary to make application to the State Board of Sanitarian Registration for registration as a Sanitarian-in-Training.
  - No experience necessary.
- Good customer service, verbal and written communication skills.
- Good interpersonal relationship skills including cultural sensitivity and competence.
- Basic computer skills and knowledge of fundamental software (i.e. Microsoft Office), email, and use of other basic office equipment.
- Proficiency with use of databases for data querying and reporting.

- Educates operators and the general public on pertinent environmental health programs and prevention techniques.
- Perform other duties as requested by Supervisor, Deputy Director and/or Director.
- Participates as needed or requested in the event of any public health emergency.
