

#### 2019 NEW DIAGNOSES: TGA REGION 3





#### 2019 DEMOGRAPHICS OF NEW CASES

- Between January and September there were 132 new HIV cases reported; 82% (n=108) had no previous tests and 18% (n=24) had a previous negative test
- 85% (112) of new cases were male
- 69%(n=75) of new cases were under 30 years old
- 64% (n=84) of the cases were African-American
- 47% (n=62) of cases were males who reported having sexual contact with another male (MSM) in the 12 months prior to diagnosis. 23% were young black males (ages 15-29) who reported having sexual contact with another male (YBMSM)

#### **EXPOSURE CATEGORY**

- 37% (n=49) of cases were males whose only exposure category reported was having sexual contact with another male (MSM) in the 12 months prior to diagnosis.
- 18% (n=24) of cases had only heterosexual sexual contact
- 7% (n=9) of cases were males that had both MSM and heterosexual contact
- 32% (n=42) of cases did not have an known exposure status






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#### DIAGNOSTIC FACILITIES

#### ACCESSING CARE SERVICES

- 83% (n=109) were referred to medical care
- 84% (n=111) were confirmed to have accessed service (n=106) or were confirmed to have had an appointment scheduled to access services (n=5)
- 5% (n=6) were lost to follow-up
