EtHE 4 Pillars



Diagnose all people with HIV as early as possible.

Treat people with HIV rapidly and effectively to reach sustained viral suppression.





Prevent new HIV transmissions by using proven interventions, including pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) and syringe services programs (SSPs).

Respond quickly to potential HIV outbreaks to get needed prevention and treatment services to people who need them.





End the Epidemic (CDPH)

The HIV testing and PrEP arm of the EtHE in CLE

Goal: Develop a comprehensive assessment of HIV testing in clinical and public health settings to create one unified data system for HIV testing information.

Three Specific Aims

Specific Aim 1: Collect and harmonize HIV testing and PrEP data

Specific Aim 2: Identify best practices for HIV testing and PrEP delivery

Specific Aim 3: Develop a clinical decision support to improve HIV testing and PrEP referrals

End the Epidemic (CCBH)

 Ryan White Part A – Applied for Ending the HIV Epidemic – main focus is Pillar 2 Treat and supplement Pillar 4 in Response

Innovative project – HIV positive diagnosis

2 Listening sessions completed with HIV community partners

End the Epidemic (CCBH)

- Application submitted October 11th
- No appropriations designated for recipients – waiting on Federal budget approval
- 12 projects submitted start March 1st 2020
- RFP for awards in the future
- Maximum application of \$2 million requested



Data to Care Overview

 Use of HIV surveillance data to create a Not in Care (NIC list)

 CCBH Part A office is the lead agency on all D2C activities in the 6-county region.

• In February 2019, CDPH, CCBH, and Part A agencies convened and agreed on the D2C Combination Model.

Data to Care Overview

- CCBH has received the NIC list from ODH and is in the process of reconciling with their Part A database.
- Part A medical providers will attempt to link individuals to care that they had previous contact with.
- CCBH will attempt to link individuals who were never linked to care when diagnosed.


Where are we in 2019?

- RW Part A payer of last resort
- Clients in CW have provided eligibility documents to complete RW intake












Race/Ethnicity




Mode of Transmission




Age at Dx
