
















Time since first case

Utilization Percent (%)


Medical-surgical adult 77% increased 1%

- Total tests hospital labs 6/3-6/9 = 13,326
 Decreased by 2,023 from last week
- Weekly hospital lab aggregate range since 5/8:
 - 10,588-15,726 PCR tests
- Overall % positive = 3.7%
 Range 3.2-4.8%

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
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Cuyahoga County COVID-19 R₀ and June Case Projections






