As of, the Cuyahoga County Board of Health (CCBH) has received report of case(s) of
COVID-19 at childcare facility located at
COVID-19 positive persons must be isolated at home until they meet the criteria for discontinuation as defined by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. Currently, there are of isolation orders for staff and or isolation orders for children.
Staff and children in close contact with a COVID-19 positive person up to two days prior to becoming ill: • Must be quarantined by the health department • Are unable to work or attend childcare for 14 days from the last date of contact
After working with the childcare facility to assess close contacts, it was determined that of staff and of children must be excluded from work or childcare due to quarantine orders.
CCBH encourages childcare facilities to use a variety of strategies to minimize the spread of COVID-19. This includes:

- Social distancing and cohorting of children and staff
- Increased routine cleaning, sanitizing and disinfecting of surfaces and frequent hand washing
- Altered parent/guardian drop-off and pick-up procedures
- Screening of children and staff for symptoms at the beginning of the day
- Temporary closing of the childcare facility for cleaning and sanitizing or when it determines it cannot safely care for and/or maintain child/staff ratios due to public health quarantine or isolation orders
