Survey Summary


A Total of 97 participants completed the survey:

There were a total of 14 Questions


- Thirteen (13) multiple choice



Q2 How important is it to you to receive Dental Care (to see a dentist to prevent dental problems and get treatment for existing dental problems)?





Q3 How Important is it to you to receive Mental Health Care Services (mental health treatment and counseling one-on-one or in a group setting)?





Q4 How important is it to you to receive Medical Case Management Services (help to access Ryan White Programs and navigate the system of care)?





Q5 How important is it to you to receive Medical Nutrition Therapy (Nutritional Counseling and Supplements)?







Q7 How important is Home Healthcare Services (professional nursing or attendant care services provided by a licensed healthcare worker in your home)?





Q8 How important is Medical Transportation (assistance provided by bus, or other means to help you get to all medical appointments)?







Q10 How important is it to you to receive Non-Medical Case Management Services (help to access housing and third party payer benefit assistance)





Q11 How important is it to you to receive Psychosocial Support Services (support groups for individuals living with HIV)




